

Current Conditions



Significant Incidents

- November 4th Shooting at 3rd and Jefferson Street
 - 17 year old sentenced to 3.5 years confinement.
- November 26^{th -} Weapon discharge at Grand Illumination
 - Suspect identified and investigation ongoing
- January 14th Shooting in the Oregon District
 - Suspect identified and warrant issued
- January 15th "Street Takeover"
 - 24 year old female arrested.



Crime Statistics December 1st to January 18th

- 60% reduction (2 vs 5) in Part 1 violent crime
- 54% reduction (6 vs 13) in Part 1 property crime
- 350% increase (9 vs 2) in Part 2 violent
- 20% increase (6 vs 5) in Part 2 property
- 350% increase (9 vs 2) in disorder issues
- 600% increase (6 vs 0) in drugs/narcotics issues
 - The increase in disorder and drugs issues is tied to enhanced police presence and enforcement operations.



Responses

- Enhanced police presence operations downtown.
 - Planned operations will continue at consistent, but unpredictable intervals.
- Engagement with schools and community partners.
 - Continue to work towards a sustainable long-term solution.
